Scientists

Members whose training, background, and occupation would incline them to view scientific activities from the standpoint of someone within a behavioral or biomedical research discipline should be considered a scientist.

Physician Scientist (e.g., Medicine, Dentistry, Psychiatry)

Social Scientist (e.g., Anthropology, Communication, Economics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology)

Natural Scientist (e.g., Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Math, Statistics, Earth Science)

Other Scientist (e.g., Nursing, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, Nutrition)

Nonscientists

Members whose training, background and occupation would incline them to view research activities from a standpoint outside of any behavioral or biomedical scientific discipline should be considered a nonscientist.

Humanities (e.g., Art, Classics, Drama, English, Music, Philosophy, Religion, Literature)
